DECISION: OBJECTION on the following grounds:

- Adversely affecting visual amenity.
 - The development is clearly part and parcel of providing power for the chicken processing plant (PA/2017/564) and is obviously the reason for siting that application on Middlegate Lane rather than further away from the crest of the scarp.
 - This development was deliberately omitted from the Chicken Processing Plant application for the 'industrial visual reasons'.
 - Middlegate Lane currently carries very little vehicular traffic. The vast number of HGVs carrying biomass fuel to the power plant on Middlegate Lane will congest the 2 metre wide road, causing damage to the environment, wildlife and verges and destroying the leisure amenity of the hundreds of people who currently use it.

- b) Points from Councillors, questions and items of interest to note:
 - Neighbourhood Plan - no update from Cllr Young, however, Worlaby PC's visioning statement has been acquired. Members discussed whether a new questionnaire was required as a few years had passed since the last one was distributed.
 - North Lincolnshire in Bloom – work continues on the refurbishment of the telephone kiosk by The Old Smithy. Removed glass will be retained in case the kiosk ceases to be used for floral displays in the future. Plant trays will still need to be purchased. Cllr Bates would like to repaint and will research obtaining the specialist paint required. Additionally, members would like to see the Royal Mail post box repainted too. Enquiries will be made as to how the PC can request maintenance work.

140218/16 Ongoing Items

Cllr Bates read in the Scunthorpe Telegraph that new powers to tackle highway verge damage are set to be used by council officers across North Lincolnshire. New Community Protection Notices (CPN) can be issued by North Lincolnshire Council's highways officers to anyone who damages highway verges across the area. This new legislation allows the council to issue warnings and official notices to those whose behaviour or actions are having a detrimental effect on the neighbourhood. Officers will also determine whether an offender should be given an £80 fixed penalty notice or be taken to court so they can be made to repair the damage caused.
