### 130618/3 Minutes of Previous Meeting

### 130618/4 Reports from Ward Councillor(s)

Ward Cllr Sherwood updated the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council:

- LED street light replacement scheme progressing well. Low Villages are due to be upgraded in October 2018.
- Ancholme Valley cycle route work continue and there have been positive talks with local landowners to ensure the works are completed by early 2019.
- Cllr Sherwood queried whether members had received any feedback from residents regarding the closure of Bridge Road, Horkstow to vehicular traffic. If there have been many, NLC will feel obliged to remove traffic order. The Editor of the Low Villages Newsletter commented that he had received 4 communications in favour and 1 against.
- A number of footpaths in the village have recently been resurfaced. Members commented that Saxby Hill and the footpath at the far end of the village is still in poor condition.

- Renovation of the telephone kiosk & North Lincolnshire in Bloom – kiosk has been repainted and some minor adjustments need to be made to the shelving system. Cllr Fagge requested assistance in planting out the following weekend.
- Cllr Fagge has been in contact with NLC who have advised that they will fund the footpath works around the church if the PC provide a quotation and arrange the contractor.

- Safer Roads Humberside traffic survey of Saxby Hill has been undertaken and assessment forwarded to members. Survey showed very little speeding, however, Cllr Young commented that the equipment had been located in the wrong place i.e. just on the bend where cars would naturally have to slow down. The figures are therefore not surprising. Cllr Young suggested contacting NLC to pass on these comments and also request again that the 30mph sign is moved further up the hill, near the last dwellings.
- Best Kept Village competition – as per the 2018-2019 budget, it was agreed to spend up to £300 on plants and associated costs.
