Public Participation

- Resident queried why Cllr Young, who now resides in Horkstow, still wished to be on the Parish Council. Furthermore, a contested election was called at the expense of over £1000. Cllr Simpson wished to initially clarify that when the election was held in May Cllr Young had not sold his property and the PC were unaware of any other interested parties wishing to join the council. Cllr Young commented that he felt that after living in the village for over 23 years, it was difficult for him to just walk away. He also believed he could continue to contribute to the PC and bring benefit from his experience. Work is still progressing with the Neighbourhood Plan which he is co-ordinating.
