100620/4 Reports from Ward Councillor(s)

Ward Cllr C Sherwood updated the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council:

- NLC have been delegated the responsibility from central government for 'Track & Trace' phase 2.
- Green waste collection restarted on the 1st June 2020.
- NLC are submitting a bid to the central government's £250M transport fund which is available to the whole country. This fund is open to walking and cycling initiatives e.g. cycle ways and footpaths.
- Normanby Hall have begun a phased reopening from the 1st June 2020.
- Leisure centres are encouraging outdoor fitness e.g. bootcamps and static cycles in their grounds.

100620/5 Highways/Footpaths/Public Right of Way

a) Updates on the following and action resolved:

- New village name sign – location needs to be finalised with NLC. Clerk to arrange site visit.
- Saxby Mill Lane, Dannels Hill and North Carr Lane repair works – outstanding. Clerk to check with NLC as to when these will be completed.
- NLC transference of responsibility for grass cutting to town and parish councils – it was agreed that the quotation from Sissons Gardening Services was accepted. Clerk to arrange contract and site visit.

- Maintenance of bus shelter at Horkstow end – outstanding. It was agreed that a budget of £20 would be set to purchase timber for repair works.

- Speeding vehicles through the village – two residents have contacted the PC to express their concerns that incidences are increasing/worsened during lockdown. The Low Villages Forum are still pursuing the community training with speed measuring equipment. The Police and Crime Commission have reported some success with cardboard cut-outs of police personnel positioned in locations that have issues and, in such areas, as on bends. It was suggested that recurring incidences at a regular time of day should be reported to Safer Roads Humber e.g. same car speeding at 5am Monday to Friday is likely to be a driver en route to work.
 - Village hedge maintenance – on hold until the end of bird nesting season.
- b) Notification of other issues – dog waste bin on Church Lane needs emptying. Clerk to report.

100620/6Police Matters/Neighbourhood Watch/NAT

- Cllr Jobling reported that he had received many emails from the Safer Neighbourhood Team which he would work through and would put anything newsworthy on the village Facebook page.
- The Low Villages Forum reported that there had been theft of livestock on the other side of the A180. Deer had also been poached from private property. Horkstow Bridge has had incidences of public nuisance (swimming/jumping into the Ancholme).
