100221/2 Declarations of Interest

100221/3 Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on the 9th December 2020 were approved by members. It was agreed that they would be signed as soon as is practicable.

100221/4 Reports from Ward Councillor(s)

Ward Councillors updated the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council:

- Some missed refuse collections this week due to the snow.
- Currently in the middle of the NLC budget process.
- KCOM are keen to invest in North Lincolnshire and are investigating their options.
- COVID-19 vaccinations are going well with 99% of over 70s receiving theirs. A mass vaccination centre will be set up in North Lincolnshire soon.
- 'In Bloom' grants are currently being processed.
- Cllr Simpson requested further information regarding the Government's Gigabit Voucher Scheme. The aim of the scheme is to help residents and small businesses with poor internet speeds upgrade to a better internet speed. Residents or small businesses/SME's (which in this case is defined as, a business who employees less than 249 people and has an annual turnover of less than £44 million a year) with internet speeds of less than 100mbps are entitled to make use of the GBVS. Those that do, need to apply directly to their supplier of choice from a list of suppliers approved by Building Digital UK (BDUK). The supplier of choice then costs the delivery of a connection and applies to BDUK to offset the costs with funding of up to £1500 for residential households or £3500 for business premises put forward by the Government. Applications to the GBVS must be made by a group of premises (two or more), so the residents who wish to apply for this may need to talk to their neighbours and apply as a pair or even a whole street (the

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more the better). Full details of the scheme, who is eligible and how to apply are available here: <https://gigabitvoucher.culture.gov.uk/>

- Cllr Szabo commented that recommendations from a Highways safety report written by Roy Hindmarsh had not been implemented, even though some years had now passed. Clerk will try to find a copy of the report. Cllr Waltham will liaise with Highways Officers to arrange a meeting.
- Additional salt bins will need the proposed location(s) to be risk assessed by Highways Officers before it is agreed.
- Rural policing has not seen a reduction in its funding as far as Cllr Waltham is aware.

100221/5 Highways/Footpaths/Public Right of Way

- a) Updates on the following and action resolved:
- New village name sign – Cllr Simpson needs to send required photo to NLC.
 - Location of dog bin – Clerk has chased NLC but has not had a reply. Clerk to chase again.
 - Saxby Mill Lane, Danns Hill and North Carr Lane repair works – North Carr Lane is flooding again. Clerk to report. Clerk will also get an update on the position of Danns Hill in NLC’s proposed programme of works.
 - Village stiles accessibility – no update. Clerk to chase PROW’s Officer.
 - Salt bin provision on Saxby Hill – the salt bin at the bottom is not being used and would benefit from being moved further up.
- b) The proposal by the Low Villages Forum to have a Morelock Battery Powered MSID Vario Radar Speed Sign to be shared by all 6 villages at a cost £503.00 per village was agreed by members.
